## GREENS & GROUNDS

Hello Everyone. I hope you all are enjoying the spring so far.

The spring of 2018 has shaped up to be another cool and moist one. Spring is usually a difficult time to get our mowing jobs done, but this one was especially tough. The rough was slow to start growing but once it took off it didn't slow down. I swear I could hear it growing and the guys and I joked how we felt like hay farmers.

Over the next two weeks the bunkers will be edged and topped off with additional bunker sand. A detailed map will be created of each bunker diagramming the depth of the sand before the project. The goal is to have 4-6 inches of sand throughout each bunker and to reach that goal we will continue to add more sand to select bunkers over the next couple of weeks.

We will also be tackling several detail items over the next few weeks. First and foremost the cart paths will received a good edging and then new pea stone will be applied.

The Grounds Staff and I look forward to seeing you all through the year and, as always, please repair your ballmarks, rake the bunkers and replace your divots. With your help, we can continue to make Chikaming a great place to play. Thank you!!
